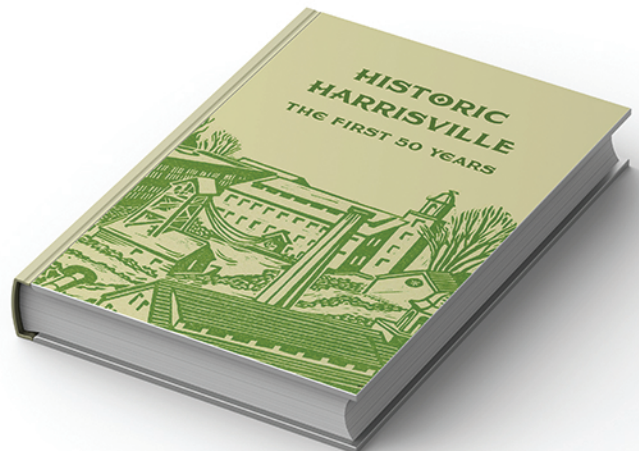

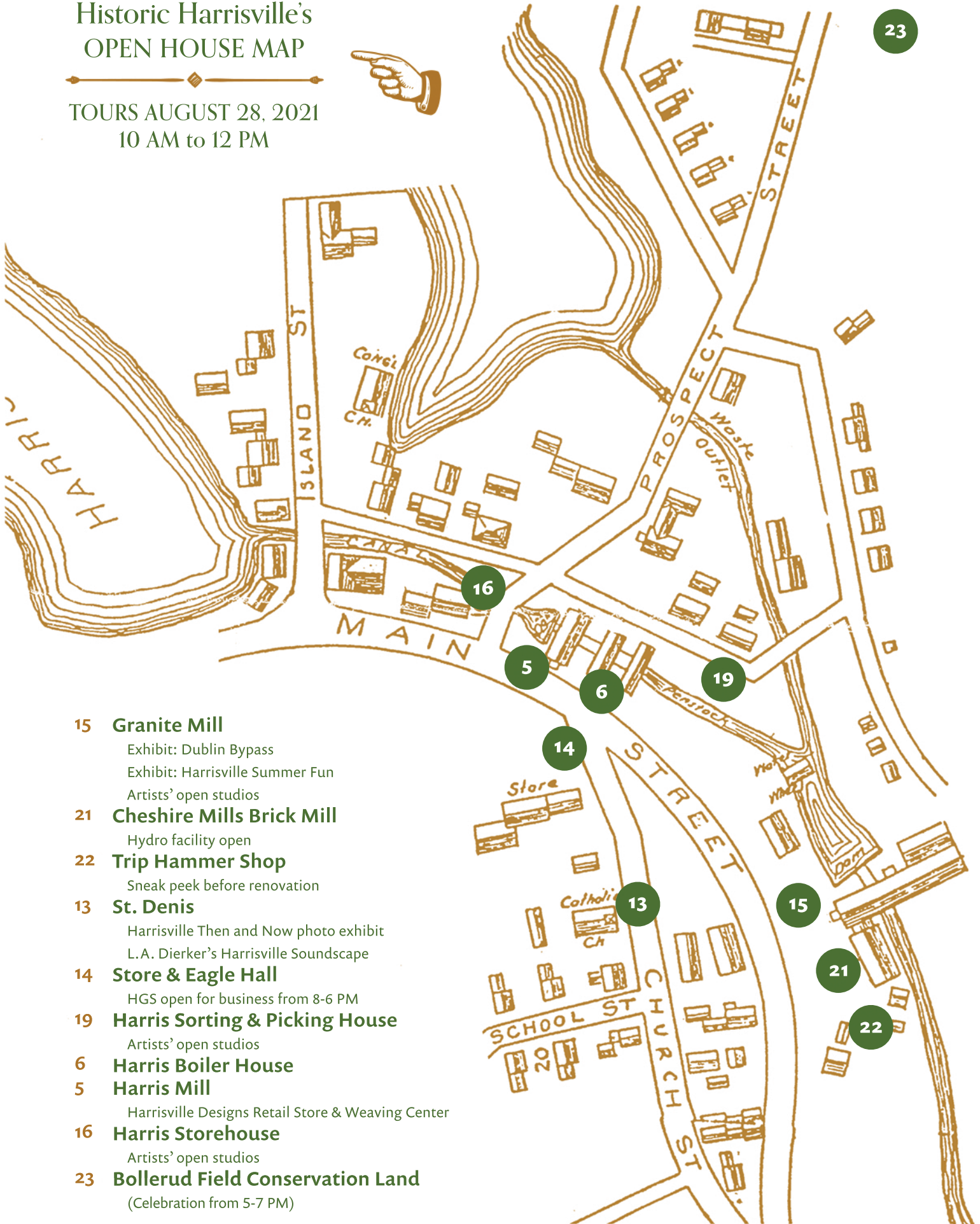


# Historic Harrisville's OPEN HOUSE MAP
